CHOOSING INTERNATIONAL BAPTIST MISSIONS

All applications of missionary candidates presented by the general director are prayerfully considered by the entire board. The board reviews the candidates' applications, medical reports, and all written references. Each candidate is asked to appear before the board to answer questions concerning salvation, call, place of ministry, personal life and doctrinal statement. The final decision on approval is made by the board.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

1. Candidate should submit a written statement to the general director indicating his or her interest in the mission board along with a request for an application form.
2. Candidates should complete the application form and return it to the general director along with the following items:
 - a. Statement indicating the candidate accepts without any mental reservations the doctrinal statement of International Baptist Missions.
 - b. Statement indicating the candidate has read the policy statement of International Baptist Missions and is committed to carrying out the same if accepted by the board.
 - c. Copy of ordination certificate.
 - d. Medical report on each member of the family.
 - e. Letter of recommendation from the church where the candidate is a member.
3. Other letters of recommendation will be secured by the IBM office.
